Quality Counts

Chick orders for the county Quality Counts Verification is stock show will be due (with a part of the process for entry payment) in our office on in all 2017-2018 major & 6 t h! county shows. The Quality Counts Verification Number is required to be included on the entry forms in order for the exhibitors to show at any of our Junior, lackpot, Scramble Shows.

> This means youth exhibitors will need to demonstrate their knowledge of the Six Pillars of Character and the Eight Core Concepts presented in the

Quality Counts Curriculum. To do this, they will need to pass an online test on the website:

http://qualitycounts.tamu.edu/

Quality acquire a Counts Verification num**ber.** A Verification number is obtained by answering 80% of the questions correctly on an online test. If you lose it, then you will have to take the test again and get a new number. You will not be allowed to enter majors without it.
